

“When I voted in the 55th ED in the 70th AD, I was given a green card after the worker examined my buff card, as though I was registered as a Democrat. When I protested that I was a registered Republican I was promptly given the correct pink card.”

Ms. Morrisey continued, “I lingered a while after voting and observed that there were no Republican Party Poll Inspectors at the polling sight. When “I discussed the incident with an associate Republican who votes in the 61st ED of the 70th AD, I was informed that the same incident occurred to him. He was automatically given a green card as a Democratic voter which was corrected after he protested. After he received the correct pink card one of the Inspectors reset the machine to display the Republican Party ballot. But he followed up and inquired as to whom the Republican Party Inspector in the ED, and everyone was simply smiled in silence.”

Ms. Morrisey is contemplating another run for elective office from Harlem as a supporter of the McCain for President campaign, but she is concerned about the lack of a viable Harlem district leadership infrastructure.

Morrisey said, “On the previous occasions when I ran for elective office I discovered that the GOP district leader infrastructure has been completely compromised by the Democratic Party leadership and the appointed district leaders serve the purpose of political window dressing. I want to run a campaign that is competitive that challenges my Democratic Party opposition. At this point I think it is the best time to make our argument in favor of bi-partisan political leverage in the Black community.”

The observations, perspective and points made by Ms. Morrisey and others are well taken and provide a basis for corrective action. That action must be undertaken in order to safeguard the ballots of Senator John McCain in November 2008 and local GOP candidates. Accordingly, there are efforts underway to advocate the need for the McCain campaign and the Republican National Community

(RNC) to take appropriate measures to ensure that Republican voters are able to exercise their franchise with confidence and security.

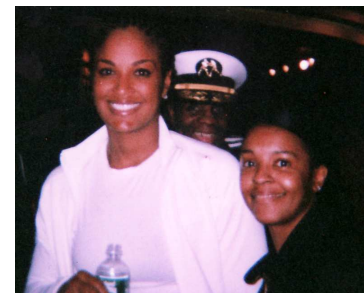
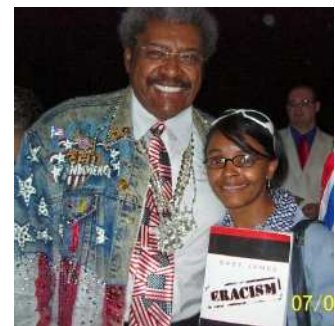
